Motion by Kirkpatrick seconded by Phillips to grant Dennis Whitehead a variance from the design standards for a sidewalk for a sidewalk not to extend to the street perpendicular to the curb except at intersections and designed mid-block crossings and a sidewalk shall be constructed of Portland cement concrete.
