Motion by Grier seconded by Bunge to approve the consent agenda:

All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Phillips seconded by McGovern to approve Resolution No. 35-09-10 hiring Samantha Garringer for child care at the recreation center at \$7.25 per hour. Roll call: ayes; MB, PM, AG, TP, DK. Motion carried.

Motion by Phillips seconded by McGovern to approve changing paragraph 8b of the recreation agreement with the Williamsburg School from \$100 per hour to \$40 per hour. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Kirkpatrick seconded by Grier to allow the Williamsburg Community School District and WHS Student Council to burn a large, upright "W" constructed by the WHS Construction Club Thursday night at the Homecoming Pep rally. All ayes. Motion carried.

The Kiwanis will donate the remaining \$679 to purchase a park slide at west end park for ages two to twelve with a five foot entry. The Lions club offered to donate \$1,000 toward the purchase of the slide.

Motion by Phillips seconded by Kirkpatrick to allow the Cornerstone EFC to use a section of the park for their Sixth Annual Halloween Safety Checkpoint on Friday, October 29, 2010 from 3-5 p.m. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Bunge to leave the Alliant Energy rebate with the city to cover expenditures paid for by the city. Motion died for lack of a second.

Motion by Phillips seconded by Kirkpatrick to apply the Alliant Energy rebate to the principal of the loan for the Child Development Center. Roll call: ayes; TP, DK, AG, nay; MB, abstained; PM. Motion carried.

Motion by Phillips seconded by Grier to approve Resolution No. 34-09-10 City Street Financial Report for FY2010. Roll call: ayes; DK, AG, PM, TP, MG. Motion carried.

Motion by Kirkpatrick seconded by Phillips to approve Bunge Web Design Services for the city's web site. Roll call: ayes; TP, DK, nay; AG, PM, Abstain; MB. Motion failed.

Motion by Phillips seconded by Kirkpatrick to approve Resolution No. 36-09-10 purchasing replacement torque tube, skimmer arms, anti-rotation bar, and scraper arms built to current design for the wastewater plant and to pay for it out of Fund 611 in the amount of \$26,250.00. Roll call: ayes; TP, PM, AG, DK, MB.
