There was a request from the Iburg-Poulson-Post 8797 asking permission to have the east side of the square blocked off for the 10:00 a.m. Memorial Day program on Monday, May 28, 2012. If it rains, they would like to use the fire station for the program.

There was a request from the Williamsburg Chamber to start its July 4th celebration with activities for the children and adults on Saturday, June 30 from 10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. They are requesting to have Court, State, and Elm Streets closed around the square from 6:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.


