3. Motion by Phillips seconded by Lortz to proceed with Option 2 for the North Trunk Sewer at a cost of \$687,758 plus Lift Station Modifications at a cost of \$100,000 - \$200,000. All ayes. Motion carried.

4. Motion by Phillips seconded by Greiner to adjourn at 8:47 p.m. All ayes. Motion carried.
