Motion by Greiner seconded by Kirkpatrick to suspend the rules and that all requirements of considering and voting on said ordinance at one or two council meetings prior to the meeting at which it is finally acted upon be waived and the requirement of publication of said ordinance and making copies available at the time of said publication prior to the passage be waived and that Ordinance No. 514 be immediately considered and voted upon. 10. Motion by Greiner seconded by Murphy to accept the proposal from American Testing and Training Inc for asbestos inspection on the three properties at the proposed library site. All ayes. Motion carried.
