It was the consensus of the Council to allow the Two Bee Racing Club to have their three-day bike race in Williamsburg on September 2, 3, 4, 2006.

The Public Works Director will work with Gloria Goeke to make more space available for the First Responders vehicle in the building that houses the vehicle.

There was a request from St. Paul's United Methodist Church and First Presbyterian Church to close Court Street between Welsh and State Streets for a worship service on Sunday, July 2, 2006.

Mitch Jeske presented more information on the Williamsburg Child Development Center. The Committee is requesting that the City donate the land which would be the land northeast of Iowa County Electronics or proposition for the acquisition of land. They also made a request for the city to apply for the USDA loan and the CDBG.

Al Haworth made a request to burn a pile of tree branches. Haworth is outside of the city limits.
