4. Motion by Phillips seconded by Lortz to set a public hearing for 7:45 p.m. on September 24, 2007 to vacate city property at the baseball fields. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Phillips seconded by Lortz to approve Resolution No. 46-09-07 calling an election to establish/continue a capital improvements reserve fund and levy a tax not to exceed 67 ½ cents per thousand dollars of taxable valuation for the purpose of street and sewer improvements. Roll call: ayes; TP, PL, DK, absent; MG, FM. Motion carried.
